HUNTINGTON, W.VA. –Valley Health -10th Street recently opened its doors to patients in need of healthcare in downtown Huntington.

Located on the corner at 540 10th Street, the newly renovated site offers convenient access to family medicine care to downtown residents and employees. The site has 2 exam rooms and an on-site lab.

“We are committed to expanding access to all, regardless of the patients’ ability to pay,” Mary-Beth Brubeck, associate CFO explained. “We feel this location offers a unique opportunity for the community to literally have the ability to walk in for quality healthcare within close proximity to where they live and/or work.”

The on-site provider is Lisa Childress, FNP. Childress also treats patients at Valley Health - Harmony House, which has provided healthcare for the homeless for almost 30 years through a partnership with the Cabell-Huntington Coalition for the Homeless.
